The Speicherstadt is the world's largest complex of warehouses. It was built into the Elbe River between 1883 and the late 1920s on thousands of oak poles as a free economic zone in Hamburg's port. Today, Speicherstadt is host to an array of leisure activities.

As of 2015, Speicherstadt proudly bears the honor of being Germany's 40th UNESCO World Heritage Site. According to the Committee, Speicherstadt — with its unique buildings and winding network of streets, canals and bridges — is an 'extraordinary example of representing one or more eras of human history'.

There's plenty to see outside the old warehouses, too. In the long canals between the former storage buildings, you can catch smaller ships making their way through the area.

#### Speicherstadt is a symbol of the connected world like no other.
